## Family Fun

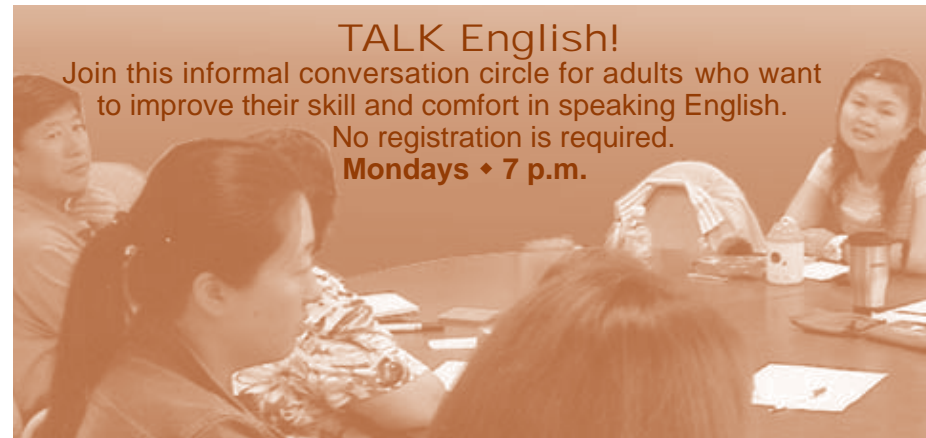
### Artist Mickey Baxter-Spade

### Senior Social

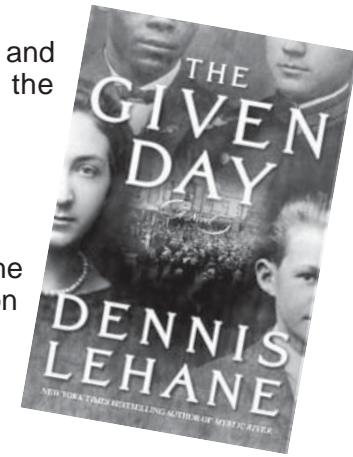

This group is open to all and meets on the first Thursday of each month. No registration required. This month's selection is *The Given Day* by Dennis Lehane.

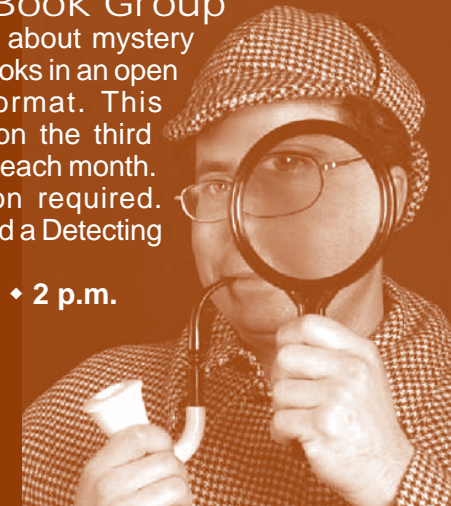

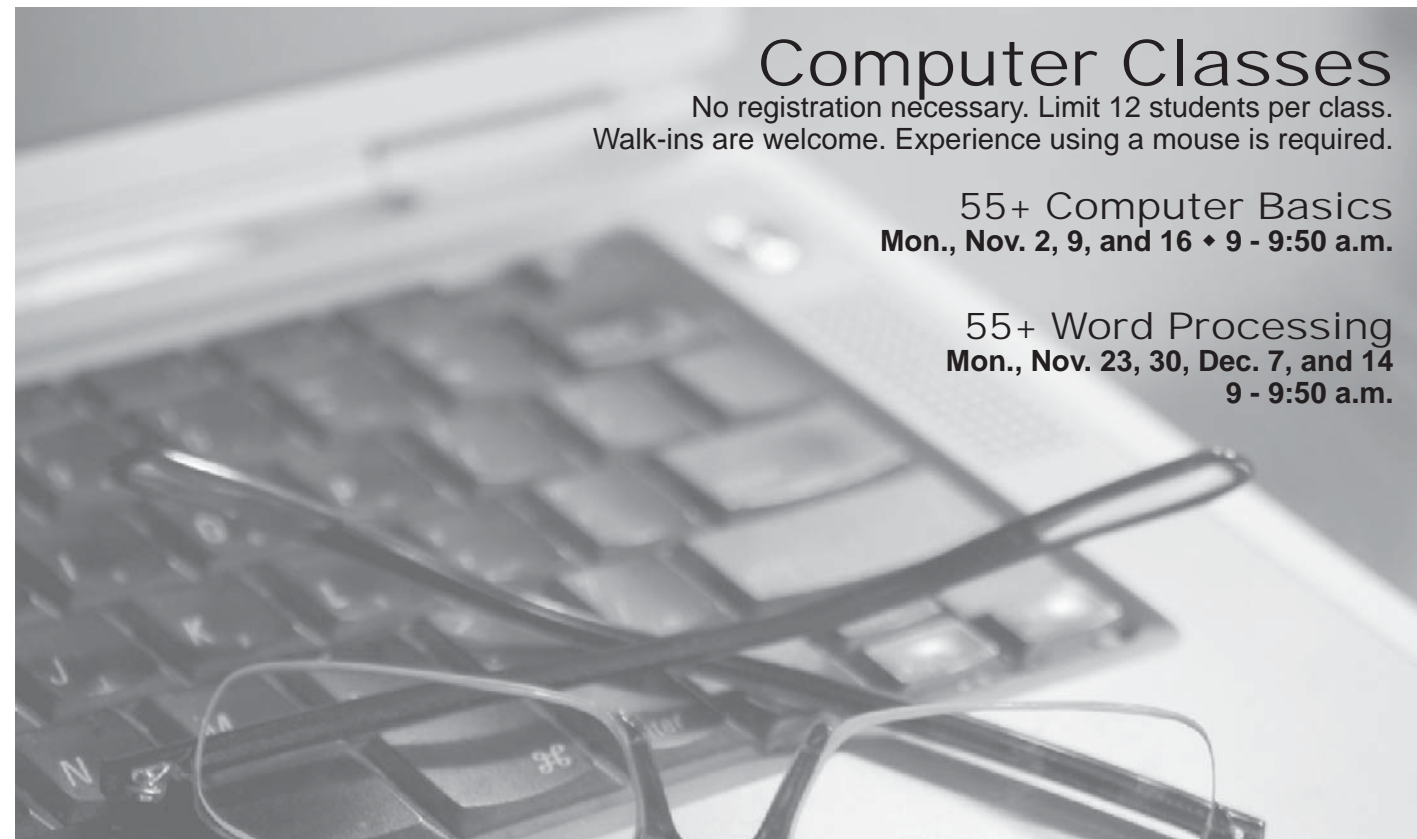


## Computer Classes
