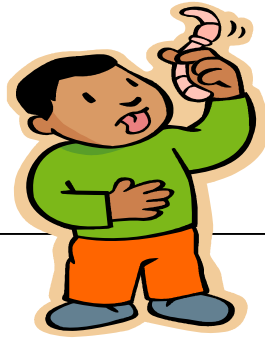


Grossly Funny Books
