How do I find information about sports at the library?

Use the Catalog

catalog.ppld.org

Type in these example search words:

sports and juvenile

football and juvenile

(or any other sport you are interested in such as : baseball, soccer, NASCAR, hockey, snowboarding and tennis)

Colorado and juvenile and biography

Just Go to the Shelf

J-Nonfiction call numbers:

792 dance and ballet

796 this large section includes: soccer, baseball, football, basketball, golf, tennis, gymnastics, ice skating, etc.

797 water sports

798 horseback riding; dog sledding

799 hunting and fishing

(Check same number on adult shelf.)

J-Biography: is a separate section in the library; athletes biographies are grouped in the same numbers listed above. (depending on the sport.)

Helpful Hints

What does Juvenile (J) mean?

Juvenile is another name for kid or child. Books with a "J" at the beginning of the call number are written for children.

What's a database?

Quality, published information in an electronic format that is bought by the library for you to use online at home, school or the library.
