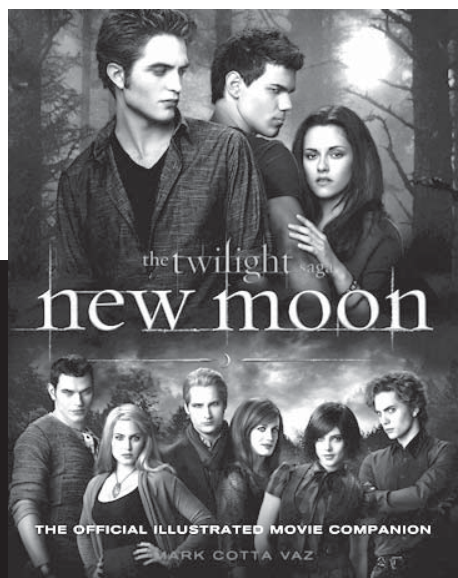


Family Fun
