- 8. To increase the 2015 General Fund budget by \$20,000 for the transfer of funds to the East Library Renovation Project Fund to partially cover the cost of the Educational Resource Center.
- 9. To increase the 2015 General Fund budget by \$120,227 for Designated Funds expenditures, funding from which comes from fundraising and or utilization of prior year fund balances.

- 2. A total of \$900,000 be set aside in a designated fund balance account to be used towards the renovation of the MacLaren Hall facility (formerly referred to as the KOC office facility).
